**Chris Fabian Inducted into National Electronics Industry Hall of Fame at NPSC 2007,  
July 26, 2007 in Denver Colorado**

**Induction speech by John Eubanks EHF, NEIHOF Chairman and NESDA Past President:**

The mission and purpose of The National Electronics Industry Hall of Fame is to recognize those individuals who, through their unusual and sustained efforts, contributed to the promotion and advancement of the electronics industry. The National Electronics Industry Hall of Fame is unique in that it is the only entity offering recognition for excellence in all segments of our Electronics Industry.

While others routinely recognize inventors, engineers and product innovators in our industry, those who provide outstanding after sales service or support was often overlooked. To correct this oversight The National Electronics Industry Hall of Fame was originally established in 1963, becoming administered by NESDA in 2001, for the exemplary purpose of recognizing outstanding contributions from the entire Electronics Industry including service and support segments.

Today it is my great privilege to welcome another outstanding individual to this cherished industry fraternity. A highly respected and well-known individual throughout our industry, whose exceptional service continues, built upon a 27-year foundation of professional excellence. He is a Vietnam Veteran honorably serving his country in the U.S. Navy from 1969 till August 1977. Afterwards he became a regional service manager for American Sign and Indicator Corporation, departing in 1982 to the Philips Consumer Electronics Company, advancing to their Director of Professional Services and National Projects. He departed in 1994 to Hitachi Home Electronics, America to eventually become Vice President of Service. In 1999 he commenced his tour at Toshiba America Consumer Products, Inc. advancing to Vice President of Service.

Along the way he left many markers of outstanding service, both civic and professional: Served as President of his Home Owners Association; Founded a Pee Wee football league; and served a term on the city council. He has served NESDA and ISCET: NESDA Advisory Board member; Earned the M.L. Finneburgh Award and ISCET Governors Award in 2005; NESDA Person of the Year and NESDA Presidents Award in 2004; and NESDA National Friend of Service Award in 2003.

Again it is my good fortune to present and welcome President and CEO of Professional Service Solutions Chris Fabian EHF into our ranks.
